



## Campus Crime and Security Report

To assist enrolled students, prospective students, and staff in being aware of any crime on the campuses of Mr. John's School of Cosmetology, in Jacksonville and Decatur, Illinois, the U.S. Department of Education requires that we furnish the following policies and statistics for the period of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2014.

- Any person witnessing some form of criminal action or emergency should report it immediately to the Title IX coordinator, School Director, or other staff member. The person responsible shall investigate the incident, report it to the local police department, and prepare a written statement documenting the incident.
- All facilities are locked during non-business hours. During non-business hours only authorized personnel are permitted access on campus.
- The school does not employ private security personnel therefore, all incidents of criminal or emergency nature are reported to the local police agency.
- During orientation, all school meetings and staff meetings, students and staff are reminded that they can assist in crime prevention by ensuring that all doors are locked, that they do not walk alone to automobiles or public transportation facilities, and that they report any suspicious activity to the schools director, or other available staff member.
- If any crimes occur on-campus or on public property near campus, the information is reported to the local police and is recorded in a crime log kept in the school office. If any arrests are made for any of the violations below, this school records the incident and reports the statistics to students and employees. These statistics are disclosed to students and employees every year on October 1<sup>st</sup> in the schools annual security report (ASRs).
- This school does not recognize any off campus student organizations.
- The sale and use of alcohol and illegal drugs are not permitted in this school or its adjacent parking facilities. Anyone observed using illegal drugs and/or any underage age alcoholic consumption will be referred to the local police authorities. The school has in place a Drug and Alcohol Abuse Prevention Program required under public law 101-226.
