## WONDERLIC ENROLLMENT PLACEMENT TEST

All prospective students are required to take the Wonderlic Placement Test before they may enroll into any of the courses offered at Mr. John's, with the exception of the High School Vocational Program.

A score of 13 or higher must be achieved by the prospective student before they may continue on with the remaining enrollment requirements for admittance into Mr. John's School.

Should the prospective student receive a score below 13 they may retest in one (1) week.

Should they fail the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) test they may retest in one (1) month.

If the prospective fails the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) test they will not be eligible for enrollment now, or in the future at Mr. John's School.

**EXCEPTION** – Prospective students that inform the school they have a current Individual Education Plan or IEP, will be allowed access to the needed accommodations for taking the Wonderlic placement test. The prospective will need to provide an IEP from their high school for review prior to taking the placement test. However if the prospective chooses to attempt taking the test without the IEP they may do so at their own discretion. Should they fail to receive a score of 13 or higher, and then wish to use their IEP they may do so. The IEP will specify what types of accommodations the student is allowed such as but not limited to, allowing the test to be read out loud, extra time, a quiet area, or use of the paper test version rather than the computer version. The prospective student must still adhere to the above test retake policy for advancing onto the next step in enrollment.
